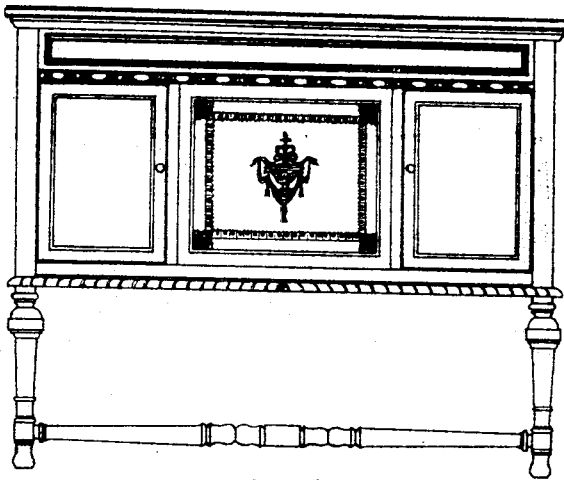

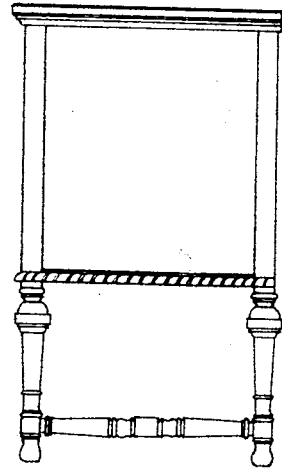

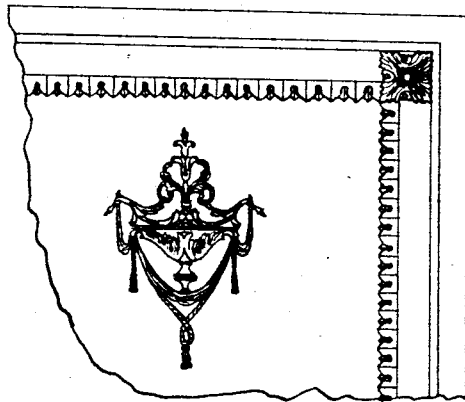

DESIGN FOR A PHONOGRAPH CABINET.

Application filed October 17, 1924. Serial No. 11,100. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, THOMAS A. EDISON, a citizen of the United States, residing at West Orange, in the county of Essex and State of New Jersey, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Phonograph Cabinets, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Fig. 1 is a front elevation of a phonograph cabinet showing my new design:

Fig. 2 is a side elevation thereof; and

Fig. 3 is an enlarged detailed view of the central panel or grille of the cabinet as shown in Fig. 1.
